

Sunday Morning Prayer Ministry, immediately after the 10:00am service:

Some people who have joined St Luke's Church recently, may not be aware of the prayer available immediately after the 10:00am service each Sunday, and on Wednesday evening.

There are always two people sitting by the organ after the service, and they have a yellow badge. They are there to pray for anyone who is in need, particularly illness of body, mind or spirit, but including also someone who comes on their behalf for prayer. They will also talk with you and pray for anything which may have challenged you during the service. Confidentiality, and trust are very important to us, because your problems are very personal, and sharing them can be a challenge.

This ministry is complemented by a group which meets each Wednesday evening to pray for the sick. We try to stay informed of who is ill and would welcome prayer. We would welcome information direct from those in need; their carers; their family; or friends. You can leave messages via the 'M' pigeon hole, by handing a note to me, by email, by telephone, or by writing in the notebook which is kept on the book stand in the chapel. **Gren Morgan**
