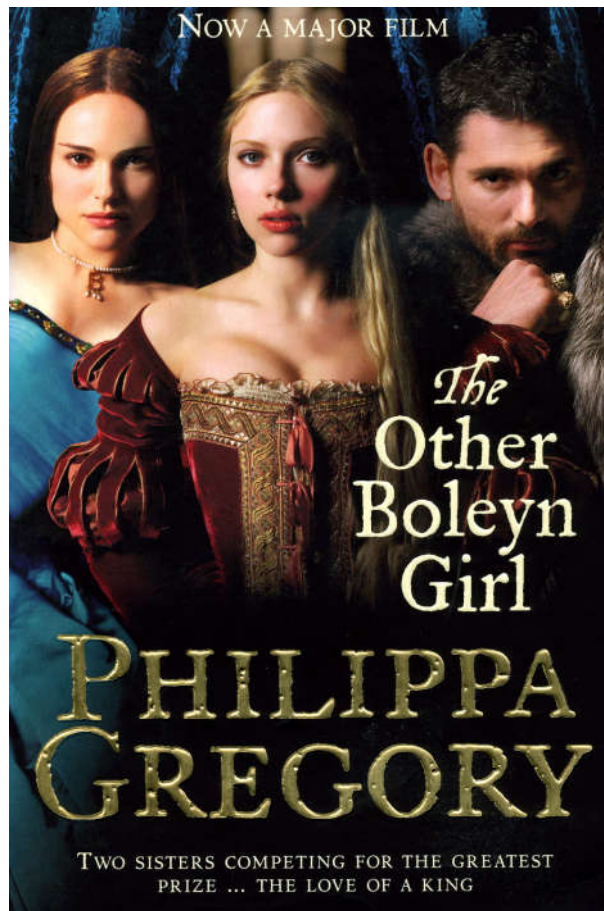


# Reading Group
