## Trustees Bulletin

The Trustees met on Wednesday 20 March. The main items were:

- Prayer together in small groups
- Trustees agreed to relocate the area in church for parents and small children to front-right, so they are not tucked in a corner and can feel more involved. They will have better facilities - cushions, blankets, appropriate toys and books etc. It will mean moving some items from right to left and rearranging some storage. This is a four-month trial beginning after Easter.
- Gateway project - meetings with the planners have led to some minor style changes that the steering group regards as sensible. The way is now clear for the formal planning processes. A separate whole-church meeting will be arranged to discuss the plans as there will not be sufficient time at the April ACM.
- Our support for International Justice Mission will be focused on their Mumbai Field Office, which rescues girls from slavery and abuse. They will provide frequent information and a speaker each year, the first one will be with us on 23 June.
- Our relationship with the Crosspool churches was clarified at a meeting with their ministers and other leaders. They are not really looking for us to take services or hold joint services. Mission and Ministry in that parish is regarded as their willing responsibility. However, background support is very valuable including help with policies and procedures, mutual support between the youth workers and generally being a 'Friend up the road'.
- A few Trustees have completed their terms of office and there are currently three vacancies. There is also a vacancy for the Trainee Warden post. Other positions will be made clear soon.
- A new home-based group was agreed for parents with small children, with helpers to play with the children so the parents can study, reflect and pray.

Trustees also:

- Approved the 2018 accounts, with a deficit smaller than budgeted. Full details will be in the Annual Report.
- Approved various policies related to Safeguarding and safety
- Reviewed the Property Report
- Noted the ongoing need for a relief cleaner, able to work when our regular cleaners are on holiday, including the Christmas period. Please let us know if you have a suggestion.
